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## **Three Christmas Cookies Recipies**

#### 1. OREO ORNAMENTS

**Ingredients**: Oreos - 1 cup white chocolate chips - 2 tsp coconut oil - Rolos - Decorations **Directions**:

- a. A Melt chocolate and coconut oil in microwave (for about 1.5 minutes, stirring every 30 seconds).
- b. Dip Oreos in chocolate and decorate!

#### 2. HOT COCOA COOKIES

**Ingredients:** 1 package refrigerated sugar cookie dough - 2 tbsp flour - 1/3 cup unsweetened cocoa powder - 12-18 marshmallows, cut in half- 1/2 cup semi-sweet chocolate chips- 2 tsp coconut oilsprinkles or other edible decorations.

#### **Directions:**

- c. Mix cookie dough with flour and cocoa. You can do by hand or with a mixer.
- d. Take about a teaspoon of dough, roll into a ball and flatten slightly. Place on parchment-lined baking sheet.
- e. Bake at 350 for about 6-8 minutes.
- f. Place 1/2 marshmallow on top of each cookie and put back into oven for 2-3 minutes until the marshmallows are golden brown.
- g. Melt chocolate chips and coconut oil into microwave for 30 seconds at a time, stirring after each interval. Continue until melted (usually about 1.5 minutes)
- h. Drizzle chocolate over cookie and decorate. Enjoy!

#### **3.** PEPPERMINT OREOS

**Ingredients for Cookie:** 1 cup sugar - 9 tbsp butter, softened- 1 eggs - 1 1/4 cups flour - 2/3 cup cocoa powder - 1 tsp baking soda - 1/2 tsp baking powder- pinch salt.

**Ingredients for Filling:** 1/2 cup butter, softened - 2 cups powdered sugar - 1/2- 1 tsp peppermint extract - crushed candy canes

#### Directions:

- a. Cream butter and sugar.
- b. Add egg and cream. Then add flour and cocoa powder and mix, slowly at first.
- c. Add baking powder, baking soda and salt and mix.
- d. Roll dough by teaspoon full into a ball, roll in sugar, and flatten onto parchment-lined baking sheet.
- e. Bake at 375 for 6-8 minutes.
- f. While your cookies bake, make your filling. Cream butter and then add your powdered sugar, a little at a time.
- g. Add peppermint extract and candy canes.
- h. Once cookies are cool, add filling and some extra candy canes. Munch away!
